



HYC COVID-19: Health and Safety Rules

To ensure a safe, healthy and enjoyable experience for everyone, all HYC members and their guests must abide by the following rules:

Corinthian (polite and respectful) behavior is required at all times.

All patrons must abide by and follow all directional signage in the club. No patrons are allowed in restricted bar areas (upper and lower levels).

Cloth mask face coverings must be worn during the following conditions:

- At all times while in the building, except when seated at a galley/bar table eating or having drinks.
- Anytime a person stands up from a galley/bar table or they are transiting through any area of the building.
- At all times (inside or outside) when social distancing of 6 feet between individuals is not or cannot be maintained.
- At all times while sitting at any table or other seating (inside or outside) during galley/bar non business hours, and when social distancing of 6 feet between individuals cannot be maintained, except when club members are using tables/seating for personal dining.

A maximum of 10 people from the same household may congregate at a table; maximum of 6 people, not of the same household, are allowed at a table.

Members and guests may not move any tables or seating in the upper and lower levels (inside) of the club; add additional chairs to tables or seating areas; or combine tables. Requests for changing table/seating arrangements must be directed to, and approved by, a club employee or club officer. When outside chairs and tables are moved, a minimal distance of 6 feet between tables and groups must be maintained at all times.

Intermingling of individuals between groups and tables is not allowed. For example, a person from group A may not sit down at the table of group B. But the group A person may talk with group B if they maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet.

No dancing is allowed at the club.

Currently, members are allowed a maximum of 5 guests in the club at any one time, per the state's limit on the number of non-household individuals allowed at a single table. The sponsoring club member must sign-in all guests into the guest log book and is responsible for their guests' compliance with these rules and their actions.

Due to COVID-19, the current maximum occupancy of HYC is approximately 159 patrons (members + guests), based upon social distancing seating capacity. This number may be adjusted at any time based upon prevailing situations. Entry to the club is subject to the prevailing occupancy numbers. Specific seating locations for patrons are subject to upper (approx. 83 seats) and lower (approx. 76) level occupancy numbers and may be directed by HYC employees or officers. If patrons must wait for seating they must do so outside of the upper and lower level seating areas.

Please remember these are new, and at times unclear, waters our club is navigating during the COVID-19 period. The club, and the wider Hawaiian community, is implementing rules and strategies to keep everyone safe and healthy. As we move forward we will adjust our procedures as new rules and guidelines are published and as we experience lessons learned. We appreciate your patience during these fluid times. Any member or guest not abiding by these rules will be asked to become compliant with the rules or may be required to leave the club or may be subject to disciplinary action per the HYC bylaws.
