Hawaii Yacht Club Transient Mooring Rules, Guidelines, & Agreement

Aloha and welcome to the Aloha Dock at Hawaii Yacht Club to temporarily moor your vessel! Please read the following rules and guidelines for your stay at HYC, then complete and sign the following agreement and provide all required documentation.

If you have any questions, please contact the Port Captain or the office.

Mooring rules and guidelines to abide by while you are here:

- Vessel owners or caretakers are required to stop at the office upon arrival to provide vessel registration and insurance to be kept on record.
- Vessel owners or caretakers are required to have a credit card on file.
- Rates for vessels mooring on the Aloha Dock are calculated per day according to the rates on page 2. One month/30 days of mooring is charged upfront, and any time not used is refunded after the vessel has departed the dock.
- There is <u>no chartering or passenger loading allowed from Hawaii Yacht Club property</u>. This is explicitly forbidden by the state government. Violating this rule will result in immediate termination of your mooring agreement.
- The Lower Galley is available for you to use as long as you treat it like your own. Please clean up after yourself.
 - When using the refrigerator in the Lower Galley, please label your food, dispose of old food, and respect that there is limited space.
 - o If the Upper Galley is open, you can still use the Lower Galley, but your meal must be taken back to your boat to be eaten.
- Your bagged trash must be taken outside of the club to the Ala Wai Harbor dumpsters.
- When using the restrooms and showers, please clean up after yourself. Make sure to check the
 hair trap, wipe up the sink, and take your toiletries with you. Lockers can be rented, based on
 availability, and are charged at an annual rate.
- We love pets and yours are welcome as long as you abide by the HYC's Bylaws. Pets off your boat must be on a leash while on HYC premises and are not allowed to use the HYC property as their waste area.
- No animals are allowed in the Upper Galley unless they are a service animal. Service animal registration is required to be provided to the office upon arrival.
- If you are moored on the outside of the Aloha Dock, please be respectful of the inside boats by treading lightly and not climbing through their cockpits unless granted permission.
- You are responsible for your crew and guest's actions while in the Club.
- While HYC has a reputation of being the "fun club" on the island, there are limits. Please *kokua* and be respectful!
- Please be aware that we have cameras throughout the Club to maintain a safe environment for our members and guests.
- While you are staying at the Hawaii Yacht Club, you are welcome to receive mail at the club. You can pick up your mail during office hours.
- There is free wi-fi for you to use.
