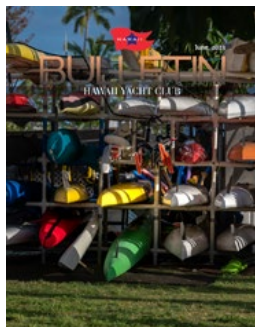

MEMBERSHIP REPORT

Aloha *kākou*,

Continuing our Hawaiian word of the month I chose the word *pono*, meaning morally right, or proper. We can all continue to strive to be *pono* in our actions.

I am pleased to report that we continue to grow our membership numbers. This growth can be attributed to several factors, including increased interest in sailing and boating activities, as well as the excellent reputation of the club within our local community. We showed an increase in total membership compared to the same time last year. Unfortunately, this increase was offset by cancellation about 40 memberships for non-payment of dues, most of these being associate members.

In terms of demographics, we continue to have a good mix of ages and backgrounds. HYC's membership base is made up of a roughly equal split between male and female members, with many of our members falling in the 35-65 year age range. We can be proud of a quite diverse membership base, with members coming from all cultural and social backgrounds.

HYC continues to offer a range of activities and events, including sailing races, fishing events, social events, and educational workshops. Please keep attending our live music events so we can continue to fund them.

Looking ahead, we plan to continue focusing on growing our membership and providing a wide range of activities and services. We will be exploring new ways to engage with members and to promote the benefits of membership in our club and to the wider community.

TREASURER'S REPORT



Aloha fellow members,

As reported at the May General Membership (GM) Meeting, there was approximately \$81,000 in the checking account after outstanding checks were paid and \$43,500 in the Maximizer Savings Account.

As members are aware by now, we have had some staff departures, including Tyler in maintenance, Marley with Junior Sailing, and Dominick and Nicole in the office. We are currently looking for a new maintenance hire. We have had our HYC accountant, Ben Choy, step in to take care of the office accounting work with help from Brandi. We also hired Abbey to help with the front of the office. I presented a proposal to the Board of Governors (BOG) to staff the office with two (2) part-time employees and our accountant, Ben, to save approximately \$37.5k/year. The BOG unanimously approved this staffing arrangement. This is an excellent labor cost savings.

The Junior Sailing Program was having consecutive net losses per month because the cost of labor and expenses were exceeding revenue from junior sailing lessons. Now that we are moving into the summer months, Staff Commodore Steven Eder is taking over the program (as a volunteer) and Junior Sailing should be operating in the black.

The Ships Store is stocked! I'd like to extend a big *mahalo* to BOG Kerri Scott and past BOG Alethea Rebman for the work on the store. Please come out and spend some money!

Finally, as presented at the May General Membership Meeting, membership was informed that it cost HYC \$134,000 to operate for the month of April and we brought in \$168,000 in revenue. Year-to-date (YTD) HYC has generated \$133k net profit, which is \$52k more than this time last year. This is a testament that the auto-pay system is working. We need to keep the ball rolling and continue to bring in more revenue than expenses each month to remain solvent.

Music has returned to HYC every Saturday in June. Please check the weekly e-mail blasts from the office for times and announcements. If you like music at your club, come out to keep it going.

HYC appreciates ALL members coming together as *ohana* and working together to make the remainder of this year a financial success, especially with Transpac this summer. We need everyone to work together to capitalize financially on this very important event.
