TREASURER'S REPORT



Aloha fellow members,

This is a kindly reminder that all members must have a form of automatic payment on file and must authorize the Hawaii Yacht Club to charge that form of payment for all fees and dues. Any member who has not completed the authorization form needs to do so immediately.

Members have been reminded recently that all dues and fees need to be paid on or before the 1st of the year, 1st of the quarter, or 1st of the month, according to membership type. **All dues and fees will be automatically charged on the proper date.** This ensures that members will not be delinquent, and we do not lose revenue.

If you do not have a payment method on file, **you are now in arrears** for the second quarter dues and for any slip fees or other charges. Members who are in arrears lose their club access until their account is current. A list of members in arrears will be updated monthly and posted in the office window.

Also, another friendly reminder is that the **NO CASH policy** is in effect. This will help us mainstream how money is collected and eliminate the chance of human error.

As reported at the March General Membership (GM) Meeting, there was ~\$88,000 in the checking account after outstanding checks were paid and \$42,000 in the Maximizer Savings Account. Even though this sounds like a good amount of money in the bank, we should really have more in the checking account to get through the year.

There is a laundry list of maintenance items that need to be accomplished to maintain HYC. Recently, we funded the rear water line at approximately \$6,500 as well as the office and lower-level dining area flooring at \$2,500. A big *mahalo* to regular member Cody Jarret for helping HYC purchase the flooring at a major discount.

As mentioned at the March GM Meeting, maintenance items cannot be deferred indefinitely or they will cost HYC more money in the long run. We will prioritize major maintenance items and program funding, but as mentioned, HYC is short on checking account funds. A special assessment may need to be held later this year, but we will reassess after we see how much money Transpac nets.

Members have been asking when **music will return to HYC** for some time. We have funded every-other-Saturday beginning April 1 and April 15 and hope to continue with various talent. For the month of April, HYC will be presenting Brant Swigart who plays music from Jim Croce, Cat Stevens, James Taylor, The Beatles, The Eagles, Gordon Lightfoot, and Seal, amongst others. Please come out to HYC and support this effort. **It will only continue to be funded if membership comes out to support it.**

Finally, as presented at the March GM Meeting, it costs **\$105,000/month** to run HYC. That includes all expenses. Therefore, we need to bring in more than that each month to remain solvent. We need all members to come in and support their club. HYC appreciates members working together as *ohana*. Let's continue to work together to make this year a financial success.
