# TRANSPAC REPORT

Transpac 2023 Is underway and there are 60 yachts expected to be arriving in Hawaii as early as the end of the first week in July. The yachts will be moored at Hawaii Yacht Club (HYC), Waikiki Yacht Club (WYC), and along the 500 Row in the Ala Wai Small Boat Harbor. The largest yachts will be in Honolulu Harbor.

The three starts for, the 52<sup>nd</sup> edition of the biennial Los Angles to Honolulu race were:

- 1. June 27, 2023
- **2.** June 29, 2023
- **3.** July 1, 2023.



"I absolutely love hosting guests onboard the *Vida Mia* and I strive to create an authentic Hawaiian experience for our guests. I have nothing but gratitude for my mentors and the people in our community that have helped make us successful. I chose to become a member of the Hawaii Yacht Club because of its rich history and belief in doing good work for our community."

Brynn is looking forward to volunteering at HYC. She says, "Although I am involved in a lot of projects right now, I have a very capable assistant that helps me meet my various responsibilities."

### TREASURER'S REPORT



Aloha fellow members,

As reported at the June General Membership (GM) Meeting, there was ~\$100,000 in the checking account after outstanding checks were paid and \$44,300 in the Maximizer Savings Account at the close of May 31, 2023. The Line of Credit (LOC) that was drawn against in December 2022 is paid off in full.

Music has returned to HYC! There will be a slightly different schedule than the past few weeks for music in July due to Transpac 2023, so please check the weekly e-mail blasts from the office for dates and times. Starting in August we will have

music on Friday nights after the Friday night race, as well as dinner, for members to relax and dance the night away, budget permitting. We need members to support this effort to keep it going. If by the end of the summer there is not enough member support, we will not be able to continue the music. Unfortunately, without members' financial support, we will need to increase membership dues, fees, minimum spends, and slip fees to address yearly inflation rates, so please come out and support your club.

The Junior Sailing Program, with Staff Commodore Steven Eder now taking over, had May 2023 revenue of \$14k and direct costs of \$6k resulting in \$8k net profit. Junior Sailing wages and payroll taxes were reduced by \$2,500 and now has a net profit year-to-date (YTD) of \$9k.

The Ships Store had May 2023 revenue of \$4.5k and a YTD total revenue of \$15k, which is \$8k more than last YTD. A big *mahalo* to BOG Kerri Scott and spousal member Pam Martin for their work in the store. Please come out and purchase some merchandise.

HYC has \$62.5k more in cash accounts and \$41k more in accounts receivable (AR's) than this time last YTD which is a testament that all the actions we have implemented this year, such as the autopay and no cash policies, are working.

Finally, as presented at the June GM Meeting, it cost HYC \$112,000 to operate for the month of May, and we brought in \$130,000 in revenue. Year to Date, HYC has generated \$153k net profit which is \$91k more than this time last YTD 2022. This is mainly due to increased and faster collection of membership dues, mooring slips, and transient mooring with autopay, as well as bar sales, Ship Store sales, and party rentals. The non-cash bar and galley has made it easier to collect and account for sales via Square. HYC employee payroll, payroll taxes, and benefits costs were approximately \$9K less than prior months due to fewer optional full-time workers. Ben is working with our insurance agent Steve Thomas to reduce workers' compensation costs with the Chubb underwriters given that we now have fewer employees. We need to continue to bring in more revenue than expenses each month to remain solvent.

HYC appreciates ALL members working together as *ohana*. Let's continue to work together to make the remainder of this year a financial success, especially with Transpac this month. We need everyone to work together, come out and support our club, or else we must increase fees and dues across the board as mentioned above.




# SHIPS STORE REPORT
