



In 2024 HYC will be offering even more activities for our members with Ikaika providing support for our growing youth sailing programs and a new adult learn-to-sail program.



TREASURER'S REPORT



Aloha membership,

As reported at the November General Membership (GM) Meeting, there was ~\$79k in the checking account after all outstanding checks were paid and \$59k in the Maximizer Savings Account on November 31, 2023.

Year to date (YTD) 2023 HYC has revenue of \$1.48M and total costs of \$1.27M resulting in a net profit of \$213k, which is \$168k more than prior YTD. This is a testament that all the actions I have implemented this

year as Treasurer, in consultation with our account Ben Choi, including the auto pay and no-cash policies, keeping up on collecting accounts receivables, and our collections agency are working.

As presented at the December GM Meeting, it cost HYC \$120k to operate for the month of November and we brought in \$99k in revenue resulting in a net loss of \$21k. However, it is not as bad as compared to last year November closing which had a net loss of \$58k. As you may remember at the end of last YTD, HYC had a \$0 cash balance in the checking account and we had to use \$25k from our line of credit (LOC). The LOC is paid off, so we are doing much better than last year.

We are enforcing boat usage once/quarter, in accordance with HYC by laws for all slip holders, including live-a-boards. Any who do not comply will be automatically charged one month's extra slip fees (double) in accordance with the bylaws once per quarter in 2024 and be subject to slip termination as per the bylaws. Also, anyone who does not have a working card on file and has not paid dues/fees on or before the 1st of the month as per bylaws will have their card access turned off on the 5th of the month. This is my last notice on both subjects.

I am unsure as to whether I will continue as treasurer of HYC next year. If not, I want to thank all of membership for all it has done to get through this Year 2023. Year 2024 upcoming is looking like it will be most challenging with two active lawsuits and the lease negotiations coming up.

I would like to personally thank ALL members for working together as *ohana* and supporting our club. I have enjoyed serving as treasurer this past year and making HYC operate more efficiently as a business.
